

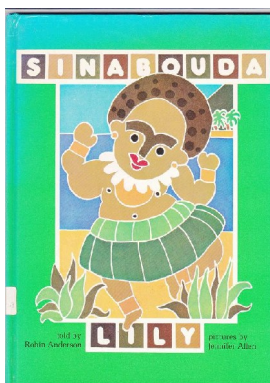
Children's Catalogue
